What you will need to show



You will need to show proof of your disability:

- Benefit award letter from DWP



You will need to show proof of your name:

- Birth certificate
- Passport
- Driving licence
- Marriage certificate



You will need to show proof of your address:

- Bank statement
- TV licence
- Council tax bill
- Electricity bill



You will also need to show your passport or your driving licence.

If you don't have one you will need to give them a photo that is signed by a professional who knows you like a teacher or a doctor.

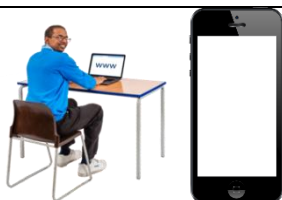

Your bus pass should arrive at your house in 2 weeks.

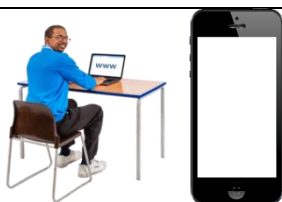
Have you lost your card?
